JOB OVERVIEW

Life Fitness is the global leader in creating premium fitness solutions and experiences, inspiring people to work out, creating healthier lives together. We are looking for a **Spanish** speaking Supply Chain Coordinator to join our international multilingual Supply Chain team of 6 which cover the Spare Parts activities for multiple geographical sales regions; Spain & Portugal, United Kingdom, Belgium/Netherlands/Luxembourg, and Germany/Austria/Swiss.

You will be responsible for the coordination and monitoring of Spare Parts in the Spain/Portugal region to support our ability to achieve targeted service levels and ultimately drive customer satisfaction, maintaining Life Fitness as a Partner of Choice.

Working as part of a collaborative team, you will manage the stock levels and order flow of spare parts by our dedicated warehouse, place purchase orders on our vendors with a requested delivery date and ship method that fulfills the demand of our Customer Service department. A vital element of this role is to capture any significant deviations and work collaboratively with the Spare Parts Planner and Supervisor to align on next steps to take.

You will coordinate the planned delivery of your purchase order and monitor the progress of it with the vendor and our warehouse, ensuring teams and systems are kept up to date with any changes. You will coordinate returns of Spare Parts from our Technicians to the warehouse, and ensure our Technicians are fully stocked with Spare Parts.





Through effective monitoring of warehouse performance, you will help reduce customer delays, working closely with the Customer Service department on any issues arising. You will also support in retrieving data from our systems and create reports to enable performance reviews of the warehouse and carriers, and decision making within the Supply Chain department.

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES

Your main responsibilities include:

- Purchase Orders: processing and monitoring of progress of Purchase Orders with our vendors, and Sales Orders with our Warehouses and Carriers.
- Order management: coordination of all administrative handling related to customer service spare parts demand, technicians, and external customers.
- **Stock management**: manage spare parts stock levels and statuses in dedicated warehouse and at the Technicians.
- Cross-Functional Collaboration: work with the dedicated warehouse team, carriers, Finance, and Customer Service to ensure inquiries are handled and accurate and timely reporting is enabled.
- Compliance: Ensure that all reporting and documents comply with company policies, and customs or industry regulations.
- **Process Improvement:** opportunity to identify process optimization possibilities in the Supply Chain processes and align with the Spare Parts Planner and/or Supervisor actions to be taken and implementation of improvements.

Other responsibilities include:

- KPI Monitoring and Creation: process data in existing reports to track key performance indicators (KPIs) related to Supply Chain processes and report these results to Supervisor on a monthly base.
- Data Reporting: Weekly generate data from our system and external platforms, and maintain data in reports on Supply Chain areas covering Inventory levels, Freight Lead Time and Order Lead Time.
